



Getting in the Groove (of Successful Facilitation)

with Mary Garrison, LCSW

This training will provide a structure for facilitation of permanency team meetings including responsibilities of a facilitator, reframing, flexibility, meeting the needs of all, and challenging behaviors. The training will also examine strategies to prepare and assist participants in meetings. Participants need to be well prepared in order to be effective participants on their own behalf. The training will be interactive and skills based.

After this training, participants will:

- review strategies for successful facilitation
- practice flexing to meet the needs of participants while staying on agenda
- identify responsibilities of facilitator
- describe ways to prepare participants for the meeting
- practice strategies for engagement and preparation

Mary Garrison, LCSW is a licensed clinical social worker in the state of Tennessee. She has worked in the mental health field providing specialized services in parent training and the evaluation and treatment of abused and traumatized children. She has served on several State committees advocating for children and their families and previously worked in outpatient care at Cherokee Health Systems. As Children and Youth Outpatient Coordinator, she worked with youth and supervised work with families and children in nine counties in the East Tennessee area, served on the Child Abuse Review Teams in three counties and worked with CPS abuse and neglect investigators.
